






























Bamboo Creations Quick Reference Guide www.bamboo-plants.com.au

Bamboo will tolerate all soil types but may take longer to establish in very heavy clay. When planting bamboo do not disturb the root ball and do not plant deeper than it is potted. Treat a new bamboo as you would any other new plant until established. Once it is established it will be extremely water wise and almost totally self-sufficient.

Large varieties can be grown in pots that will restrict their overall height if you do not have the space to put them in ground. If you have the space but do not want the height, bamboo can be pruned to any height and will not re shoot from the cut. This is a once a year job as clumping varieties shoot from mid to late summer and spreading varieties shoot from mid to late spring, spending the rest of the year building up energy to release it all the following season.
